Teenage Conception (15-17 years)









Index of Multiple Deprivation (2010) - Measure of relative deprivation at small area level. IMD consists of 38 indicators that have been grouped into 7 domain, which are income, employment, education, health deprivation and disability, barriers to housing and services and living environment deprivation. There are two supplementary indices - Income Deprivation Affecting Older People Index (IDAOPI) and Income Deprivation Affecting Children Index (IDACI). Domain for each ward is scored and ranked (1-10 nationally). A high score corresponds to a low rank (low rank = higher level of relative deprivation)


