The Parish is reviewing its Neighbourhood Plan so a grant was obtained from Locality (£2935) to fund this work. Advertising rates were increased by 10% for the village magazine, so the income increased by £50 from £518 to £568. The VAT repayment in YE 2019 was £3834 compared to £2057 in YE 2018 due to expenditure on outdoor fitness equipment. A difference of £1777. The Council no longer receives a support grant from the District Council which was £1060 in YE 2018. Interest earned in YE 2018 was £25 compared to £126 in YE 2019 due to a change of bank. A difference of £101. Sundry receipts in YE 2019 of £624 were due to a returned donation and a credit for an incorrect bill. In YE 2019 £470 was received for an insurance claim and the credit of a duplicate invoice.
