

CLERK'S REPORT – meeting on 20 May 2024

The Race to the King will take place on the same route as last year on 15th and 16th June 2024.

The bench at Deeside Avenue has been installed and residents have sent in their thanks.

In answer to a question about the Whitehouse Farm Clay Lane access which was raised at the annual meeting, the situation has been clarified thus: access for vehicles to/from Clay Lane and the sports facilities will be maintained until such time as the Southern Access Road (SAR) comes on line. After that point, anyone driving to the sports facilities will need to do so via the SAR.

The Clerk received a reply from CDC Divisional Manager to the Council's request that the District Council use Grampian conditions wherever possible, assuring the Council that this is carefully considered and that the Major Applications team will be made aware of it.

The Clerk received a response from National Highways to the Parish Council's letter outlining the local concerns in regard to a possible A27 upgrade. The response was that the Council's comments have been passed on to the team and should the project resume the Council will be involved in any stakeholder discussions.

NALC has issued updated model Financial Regulations which will be prepared by the Clerk for consideration at the June meeting.
