**Subject: Repainting bus shelter**

It was decided to repaint the bus shelter at Appledram Lane South. **Three quotes were sought but only two received.**

The contractors were asked to ensure the seat is well sanded and to paint over the graffiti. I asked for Sadolin paint as Cllr. Mason recommended this be used last time the shelter was painted.

Decorating Work Consisting of  
Wash Down with Sugar Soap  
Scrape off all loose paint and Rub down until smooth  
Give a coat of Bedec Barn Paint  
Light rub down  
Apply final coat of Bedec Barn Paint

**Total Amount for Materials and Labour £300.00**

**Additional notes:**

Regarding the bench inside the bus shelter, rest assured it will receive a thorough sanding to eliminate any chance of splinters, ensuring a smooth and safe surface for everyone.

As for the paint product, I'd like to recommend using Bedec Barn Paint instead of Sadolin. In my experience, Bedec Barn Paint is a superior product and offers greater durability. I've used it on numerous projects, including Lavant House Riding Stables, and it has consistently performed excellently without any issues.

**Green's Decorating Services**

Wooden bus shelter  
sand back the graffiti/ stain block graffiti  
light sand over bus shelter for a keyed surface for paint to adhere to.  
apply 2 coats of sadoline superdec opaque, (colour to match existing)  
clean up around bus shelter to make presentable  
(this price includes shelter and the bench)

**Total cost: £ 350**

**Additional notes:** *this price is for a stain block or a heavy sand on graffiti, a key, and 2 solid coats for the finish.*

**Action from Council:** to choose a preferred contractor for the repainting of the shelter.
